# WORLD GENDARM

After the collapse of the USSR, the balance of power disappeared, which allowed the United States to begin global expansion - in Iraq, in Yugoslavia, and after "September 11" - in Afghanistan, then in Libya and Syria. Labor and capital all over the world have come face to face, without intermediaries in the form of a "socialism" camp. The competition between the US and the EU sharply intensified, the war of the euro and the dollar began. Therefore, Washington needed to reanimate the old image of an external enemy. A provocation followed with the Georgian attack on South Ossetia in 2008, then there was the maidan-2014 in Kiev

Washington resumed the Cold War, the Kremlin declaratively supported it. However, the bourgeoisie in Russia has not yet matured from class-in-itself to class-for-itself. Therefore, the state in Russia is weak, the government is not even able to collect a progressive tax, totalitarian Russia is just an American myth.

The Russian bourgeoisie continues to remain a comprador oriented to the West. So, oil tycoon Alekperov announced that he is more interested in the United States and Ukraine than Russia, Russian oligarch Abramovich created production in the USA and Canada, another Russian oligarch Mordashev created high-tech production in Detroit, Moscow keeps the stabilization fund in US banks at 1%.

The government and the president of Russia are executing the orders of the ruling class of the Russian comprador export bourgeoisie. In response to the sanctions, Moscow supplies the United States with titanium, oil, engines for intercontinental ballistic missiles aimed at Russia, and other missiles with these engines launch satellites monitoring the territory of Russia into space.

At the request of the IMF, the Kremlin raised its retirement age.

Liberal reforms in Russia, carried out under the dictation of the United States, since 1991 claimed 30 million lives.

Thus, Russia is a hidden ally of the United States, both in the economy and in foreign policy. So, Moscow supported the US sanctions against North Korea.

Let's see who Moscow chose as its allies.

#### Indians and blacks

- The problem of hunger and homelessness is very serious, at present there are more than 2 million homeless people in the country, some of which are war veterans.
- Only when transported from Africa, 9 million blacks died. A tablet with the saying of US President Jefferson flaunts in Liverpool, the Museum of Slavery that slavery, despite the costs, served to develop the American economy.

In the USA, the last segregation law was repealed only in 1964.

Dog Laika was sent into space, knowing in advance that she would die. After that, a letter from a group of women from the state of Mississippi arrived at the UN. They demanded to condemn the inhuman attitude to animals in the USSR and put forward a proposal: "If it is necessary to send living creatures into space for the development of science, there are as many Negroes children in our city for this."

In the United States, discrimination against blacks and representatives of other national minorities in employment and wage levels continues. The unemployment rate among blacks is more than 2 times higher than that of whites.

On November 7, 2017, the National Registry of Exonerations published data according to which a black man is 8 times more likely than a white man to be convicted of a murder that he did not commit, and 12 times more likely to be mistakenly convicted of drug-related crimes. Black men are sentenced to imprisonment, which is on average 19.1% longer than that sentenced by white men in "similar situations".

In the US, cases of killing black children by police are frequent, the court is always on the side of the police. All this happens against the background of official propaganda of tolerance, multiculturalism, the obligatory presence of blacks in every theater troupe, film, in government structures and the implanted replacement of the word "black" by the word "African American."

During the years of the colonization of America, the British with the Spaniards exterminated, according to various sources, from 103 million (according to the calculations with the Verhulst equation) to 120 million Indians.

The indigenous population of America still lives on reservations with no rights.

### Felon state

- There is a serious situation with the disappearance and abduction of children. About 1 million such messages are received annually.
- A huge number of street children, more than 2.5 million children and adolescents. One in seven Americans between the ages of 10 and 18 leads a wandering life.
- In the USA, 56% of the total number of drug addicts in the world are registered. About 86% of all drugs produced in the world are used in the USA.
- The United States ranks first in the world in the number of firearms in private hands. consequences: 30,000 deaths annually.
- The United States has one of the highest crime rates in the world. Not by the number of murders per 100 thousand people (Honduras, Venezuela and others are leading here), but by the number of robberies, rapes, and banditry.
- In the United States, even teenagers are sentenced to death.
- More than 2.6 million people are kept in American prisons, more than in the USSR under Stalin. Prisoners are often sexually abused, including by prison staff. More than 13% of prisoners become victims of sexual violence. According to the Department of Justice, the United States leads the world in the proportion of prisoners and convicts in the total number of adults in the country.

The United States is the only country in the world in which prisons use guard dogs to intimidate prisoners.

- The USA contains more than 50 illegal prisons in different countries, around the world.
- American intelligence agencies have been practicing abduction, torture and murder of citizens from different countries for many years.
- In 2014, more than 1,700 unarmed people were killed during the detention. During the 5 months of 2015, more than 500 unarmed people were killed during the detention.
- In 2014, a report was published on the use of numerous LEGALIZED forms of torture against citizens of different countries without charge.
- In the mid-twentieth century, the United States practiced sterilization of women of any age, under the most ridiculous pretexts.
- During Prohibition (the first half of the twentieth century), the US government poisoned beer, which led to the deaths of thousands of people.
- Medical errors are the 6th largest cause of death in the United States, while the medical care system is aimed at the wealthy, only 27% of the population have medical insurance.

As for democracy, 04/20/2018 The US State Department published a report on the situation of human rights in the world for 2017, in which the United States position itself as a "human rights defender" and take on the role of "judge in the human rights issue". What is the situation in the USA itself?

- During the Great Depression, due to dispossession of farmers by banks (read Steinbeck's "Bunches of Anger"), more than 8 million people died according to demographic estimates. According to similar estimates, during the period of Stalin's rule (except for World War II) 5 million deaths above normal.
- The President of the United States is elected by an electoral college whose opinion may not coincide with most US citizens.
- The US Senate Agricultural Bill S-510, passed in June 2010, under the threat of criminal liability prohibits the cultivation, sharing, exchange or sale of products grown on a garden plot. He also instructs American farmers what to plant, in what quantity and how to grow. This bill is published under the title "Act for the Control of the Safety of Farmed Foods".
- In the USA, freedom of speech is not allowed, a teacher who told the children, that Santa Claus does not exist, got fired.
- In the USA, journalists are killed with impunity.

In February 2015, journalist Ned Colt (NBC) was killed in the United States - "died of a stroke." He was allegedly abducted during the war in Iraq, was held captive for several days, and then released.

Bob Simon (CBS) died in a car accident. He was also allegedly abducted and was held captive for 40 days in prison in Iraq.

David Carr (The New York Times) suddenly died after an interview with Edward Snowden and had just started a debate against NBC's Brian Williams, calling Williams a liar for the story that he was allegedly shot down during the Iraq war.

Bob Hagerr, an NBC aviation expert, crashed with his wife in an accident.

Brian Williams, caught online on lies about the Iraq war, is also killed.

Four journalists are dead within 24 hours, in the United States, not in a war zone.

Those journalists who oppose the "party line" are either fired or imprisoned like Assange.

- 1967 - a riot in Detroit. Fire to defeat, 43 died, about five hundred wounded. More than 7,000 people were arrested.

1970 - the shooting of students at the University of Kent and Jackson. Four were killed in one, two in the second.

On May 2, 1992, 7300 police officers, 1950 sheriffs, 10,000 National Guard troops, 3,300 U.S. Army and Marine Corps officers, 1,000 FBI officers, armored vehicles, combat and police helicopters were brought into the city to suppress a peaceful demonstration in Los Angeles. There was opened fire to kill, according to various sources, from 50 d to 100 people. killed, more than 12 thousand people were arrested. About 500 people from among the detainees received a prison term of 25 years and up to life imprisonment. There were no complaints from the UN and the world community. Officials guilty of using force against peaceful demonstrators were not punished.

2011-2012, in various cities of the United States, during the dispersal of the rally Occupy Wall-street protests, gas, plastic bullets, and batons were used against the protesters.

There are 91 organizations in the United States with the right to arrest you.

To the above, you can add total surveillance, revealed by Snowden.

### Rich America

Every fifth American homeless has a job, but he doesn't even have enough money to rent a room." Many live in their cars, because sometimes an old car is cheaper to buy than paying for an apartment. 15% of American families live below the poverty line. 42% of the US population lives near the poverty line. 36 million Americans are starving (15% of the population). In the 80s, 12% of Americans consumed only a sandwich per day.

- 27% of the population do not have health insurance.
- For 2014 in the USA more than 350,000 suicides.
- In the United States, most of the food is harmful, with GMOs, hormones, chemistry, and also falsified. American corporations produce the largest amount of fast food and carbonated drinks in the world.
- Every third American is obese, the average American consumes the same amount of resources as 32 Kenyans.

### Threat to humanity

- The USA consumes 50% of the world's energy resources.

At the same time, real production in the USA is only 20% (the rest is the speculative sector, including hedging, etc., which served as the basis for the 2008 crisis), i.e. power consumption is mostly personal.

- The USA is one of the main suppliers of GMO products in the world.
- 50% of all air emissions are from the USA.
- Only the US public debt in 2019 amounted to 23 trillion. dollars, the total debt of the United States in 2001 amounted to 370 trillion. doll.
- After the invasion of the United States in Afghanistan, the supply of opium poppy from Afghanistan increased tenfold.

## The world's first killers

- Over the past century, the United States, under various pretexts, has invaded more than 60 countries of the world. The loss of civilian population in these countries, according to conservative estimates, exceeded 80 million people (more than all the victims during World War II).
- During the two months of the occupation of North Korea, the US military exterminated 1 million civilians with torture, Himmler is resting.
- In Vietnam, the Americans used chemical weapons, conducted medical experiments a la Mengele over captured Vietnamese.
- The USA is more than 700 military bases in 130 countries of the world, and the maintenance of bases is paid for by these countries.
- The United States is the only country to use nuclear weapons against civilians.
- In the USA, elements of chemical weapons, parts of nuclear weapons, and strains of deadly viruses and

bacteria are constantly disappearing without a trace.

- In all recent wars, the United States massively use prohibited weapons: cluster, phosphorous, and also with depleted uranium bombs and shells - thereby causing local contamination of the area.

In Yugoslavia, the United States killed 2,000 civilians, including children (bombed kindergartens), 6,000 were wounded and crippled, in Iraq, more than 0.5 million civilians were exterminated, a humanitarian catastrophe in Libya, and unleashed a war in Syria.

Of course, in every moment with a subtitle only a small part of the overall picture is ajar, the overall picture is much worse.
